

The Joy and Power of Biblical Faith

The Purpose of This Study: The emphasis in the Bible on the subject of faith is overwhelming. We are reminded that "without faith it is impossible to please God" (Heb. 11:6), and "whatsoever is not of faith is sin" (Rom. 14:23).

The clear teaching of these two passages bring us to the realization that the believer must learn the meaning of faith, seek to understand its practicality, faithfully apply it to life, and carefully avoid all those areas of thought and action which would be out of harmony with faith.

In this study we shall seek to understand the relevance of these two passages in our daily walk with God. As we consider the various facets of faith we must pray for one another that we will truly become -- men and women of faith.

Recommendation: Spend at least one-half hour a day studying the Word of God and the lesson. Work hard to make the application of each truth a part of your daily life. Pray for illumination concerning character defects, sins of omission and commission, and giving ground to Satan. Be honest with God and yourself. Accept the truth that the Lord God wants to make you a person characterized by faith with all the fulness of its joy and power.
