THE PURPOSE OF THIS STUDY

The objective in this study is to be taught by the Holy Spirit, from the Scripture, the amazing grace of the True and Living God. THE RECOMMENDATION

There is nothing more practical, more beneficial, and more enjoyable than the application of Christianity in the believer's daily life. It is an experience of becoming more and more profoundly involved with God. This involvement, characterized by faith and love, increasingly transforms every facet of the believer's character and life. God has made every provision so that we may be successful in living the Christian life. It is not His will that we fail. In fact -- to fail, we must get out of His will.
