The Purpose of this Study: Priorities are important. They are probably the most powerful influences in our lives. Our priorities largely determine our daily goals, which in turn determine our character, which in turn determine our future.

By accepting and implementing wrong priorities we set a course for ourselves which will be, in some way, self-destructive. (Mark 8:35,36)

By accepting and implementing Biblical priorities we are assured of success. (Joshua 1:7,8; II Peter 1:5-12)

This class may present to you the key for which you have been seeking.

<u>The Recommendation</u>: Spend at least one-half hour a day studying the Scripture and the lesson.
