

## That Which We Know For Sure

### Introduction

- A. We have all heard the questions "What do you know for sure?"
- B. There are many responses to this question. Not often, however, do you have a person state some of the things he does know for sure.
- C. Are there some things that we know for sure? The Bible lists a number of truths accompanied by the words "We know".

#### I. The Certainty of Truth, Guilt and Future Judgment, Romans 3:19.

Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are tinder the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

#### II. The Certainty of Providential Provision for the Christian, Romans 8:28.

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose.

#### III. The Certainty and Assurance of Going to Heaven, II Cor. 5:1.

For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

#### IV. The Certainty of God's Faithfulness and His Righteous Judgment, Hebrews 10:30.

For we know Him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto Me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge His people.

#### V. The Certainty of the Assurance of Salvation, I John 2:3-5.

And hereby we do know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. He that saith, I know Him, and keepeth not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth His Word, in him verily is the love of God perfected hereby know we that we are in Him.

#### VI. The Certainty that the Christian Shall be Like Jesus Christ, I John 3:2.

Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be; but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

#### VII. The Certainty of a Basis of Authority and Assurance, I John 3:19,20.

And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him. For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.

#### VIII. The Certainty of Divine Indwelling and the Promise of Ability, I John 4:13.

Hereby know we that we dwell in Him, and He is us, because He hath given us of His Spirit.

IX. The Certainty of Confidence in Prayer, I John 5:14,15.

And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He heareth us. And if (since) we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.

X. The Certainty of Ability to Live the Christian Life, I John 5:18.

We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but He that is begotten of God keepeth himself (him), and that wicked one toucheth him not.
