

The Person of Jesus Christ in the Book of Hebrews

Introduction

- A. Christianity or the Gospel revolves around the Person of Jesus Christ (John 14:6)
- B. Christianity is first of all a personal matter. It has to do with our personal relationship with Jesus Christ. (John 1:12)
- C. God has determined that Jesus Christ is to have the preeminence in all things. (Col. 1:18)
The key to the believer's spiritual success is to give Jesus Christ His rightful place in daily life. (Romans 12:1,2)
- D. The titles of the Lord Jesus Christ indicate His greatness and suggest to the believer what it means to give Him rightful place.

I. Jesus Christ is the Son of God, Hebrews 1:1,2.

God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, hath in these last days spoken unto us by His Son, whom He hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also He made the worlds.

II. Jesus Christ is the Heir of All Things, Hebrews 1:1,2.

III. Jesus Christ is the Captain of Our Salvation, Hebrews 2:10.

For it became Him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the Captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

IV. Jesus Christ is our High Priest, Hebrews 2:17.

Wherefore in all things it behoved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

V. Jesus Christ is the Apostle of our Profession, Hebrews 3:1.

Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus.

VI. Jesus Christ is our forerunner into Heaven, Hebrews 6:20.

Whither the Forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an High Priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

VII. Jesus Christ is the Mediator of the Better Covenant, Hebrews 8:6.

But now hath He obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also He is the Mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.

VIII. Jesus Christ is the Author and Finisher of our Faith, Hebrews 12:2.

Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; who for the Joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

IX. Jesus Christ is our Great Shepherd, Hebrews 13:20.

How the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that Great Shepherd of the Sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ; to Whom be glory for ever and ever, Amen.

- B. These titles of the Lord Jesus Christ remind us of the fullness of provision that God has made for us.
