- B. No one can doubt the world of science that exists apart from our everyday sensations, or the world of justice, or value, or love. We must face the existence, the reality, the promise, and the demands of the spiritual world.

I. The Evidence of an Amazing Person – Jesus Christ.

- A. His birth was announced by an angel. Luke 1:26-38
- B. He was born of a virgin. Matt. 1:18-23
- C. His life was characterized by miracles. John 20:30,31
- D. His death was a substitutionary sacrifice. Mark 10:45
- E. He was resurrected from the grave. John 20:1-28
- F. He ascended back into the spiritual world. Acts 1:9-11

II. The Evidence of an Amazing Priority – Divine Love.

- A. The fact of that love. Romans 5:8

But God commendeth (proved, manifested) his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

- B. The content of that love. Matthew 11:28-30
 - 1. He recognized us as persons.
 - 2. He gave us our rightful place in His life and plan.
 - 3. He always did what was right by us.

III. The Evidence of an Amazing Plan – He came to rescue us.

- A. The unawareness of our need is proof of its depth. Eph. 4:17-19
- B. The extent of our need is measured by infinity. Rom. 6:23
